Kenan-Flagler Leadership Development


- Leadership development a strategic initiative
- Need for faculty with leadership responsibilities to see themselves as leaders critical to the success of Kenan-Flagler and its priorities
- Need to think beyond the individual or the area
- Need for synergies within and between units
- Need to develop more unity/sense of partnership between faculty and staff leaders



Kenan-Flagler Leadership Development

- "Practice what we preach"
- Leadership program for faculty and staff leaders
 - 360 feedback as part of annual reviews under way for faculty and staff leaders
 - Off-site event planned for this summer as first step in leadership development and team building program
 - Development of a more extensive leadership development program drawing on faculty expertise and experience in Executive Development and the Leadership Initiative for students
