





Student Population









International vs. Domestic 1st year enrollments






International Application Trends (% changes, national)








International Application Trends (% changes, UNC-CH)

Conclusions

- Enrollment of international students at UNC-CH is about 1/3 the national average
- Impediments to international enrollment include lack of tuition support
 - STEM disciplines are disproportionately impacted
 - Nations like China, Korea and India are investing heavily in graduate education

 - Increase international graduate student population


