In December 2016, Carolina Stories (stories.unc.edu) posted its 200th story. The Development Marketing team promoted this milestone via targeted email, social media and various websites.


- 200+ stories






In Q2 of FY17, Development Communications implemented a new strategy to increase and promote Carolina Stories through social media, generating double and triple digit increases in engagement.





Example of video—the future of social engagement


