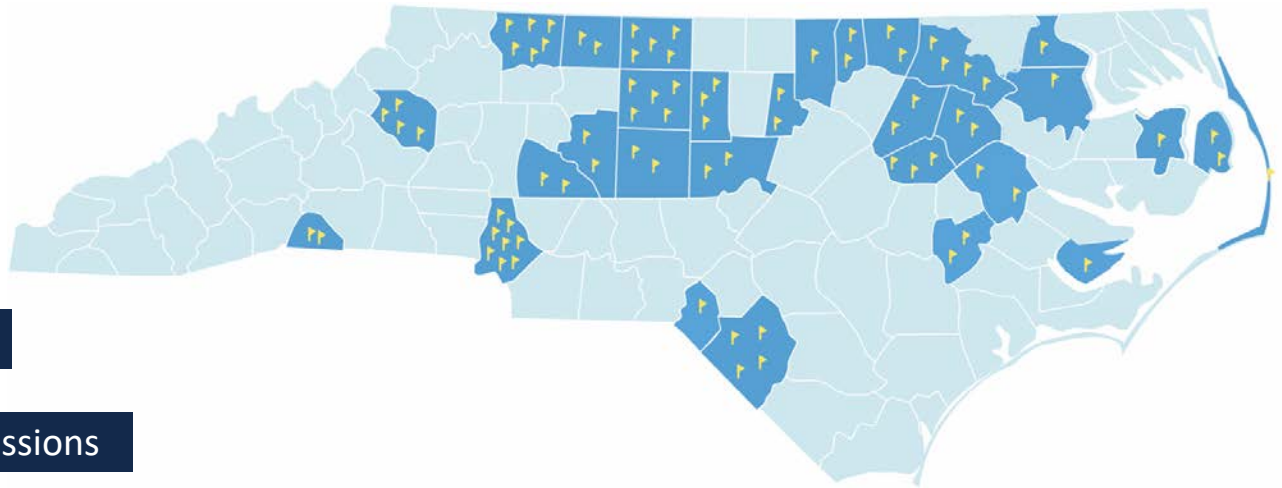

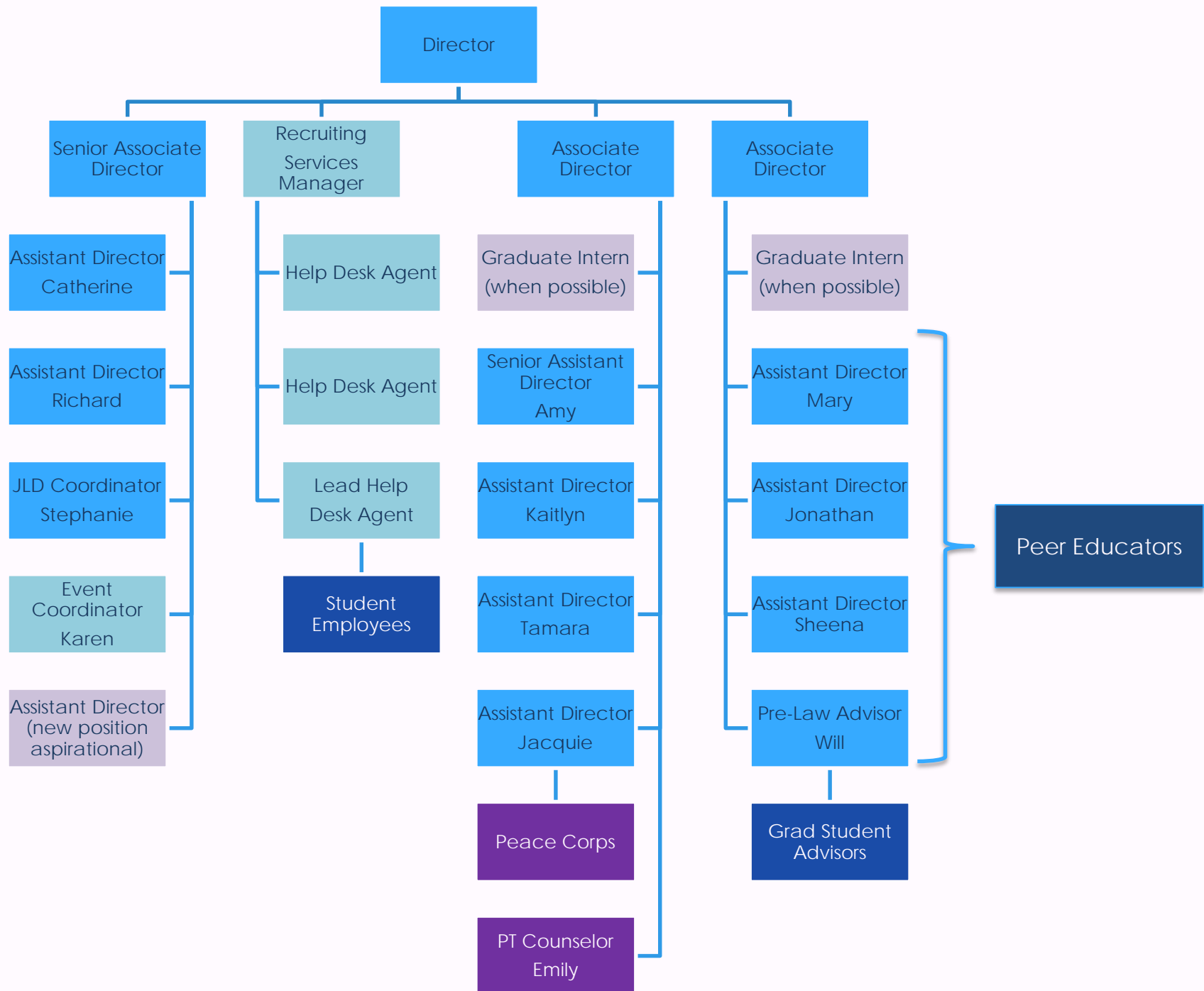

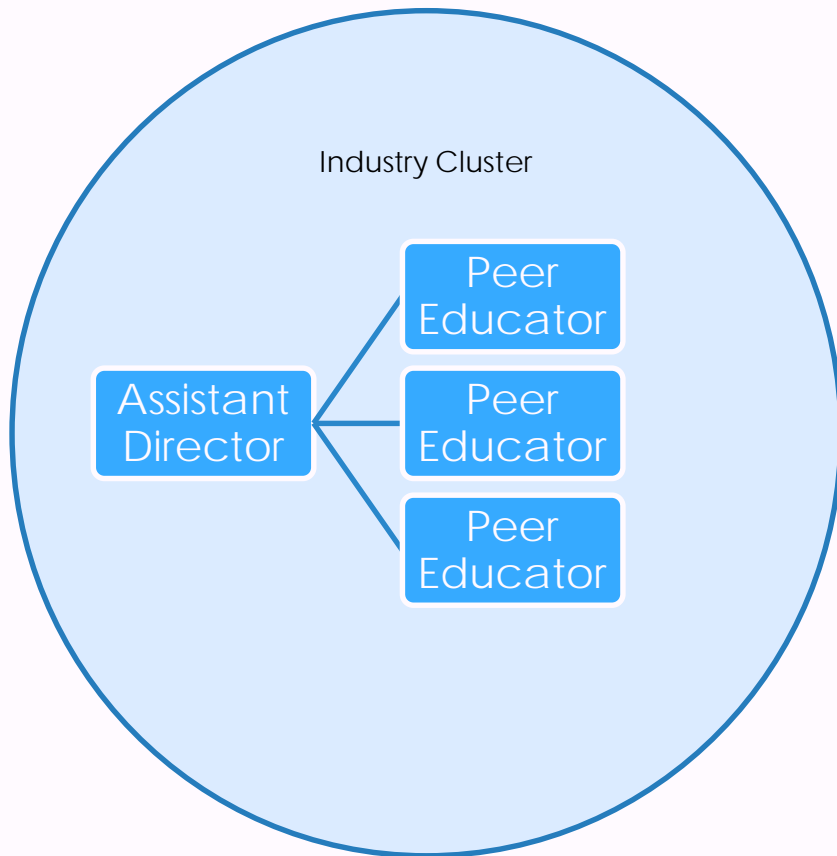

Office Structure



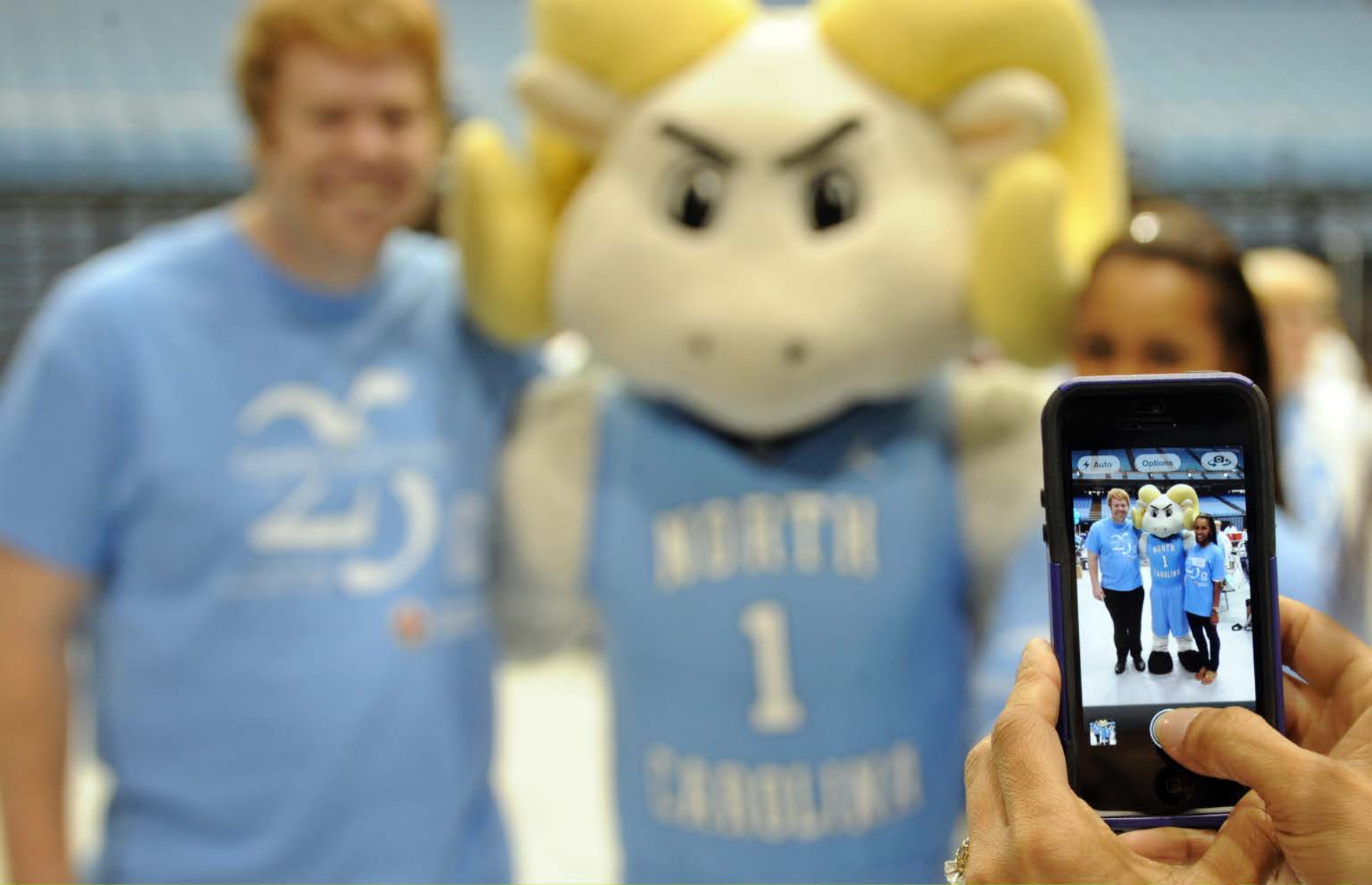
