- Develops powerful and lasting connections with local/global communities
- Uses music to teach entrepreneurship and conflict resolution

Entrepreneurship

- Engages artist/entrepreneurs as co-teachers
- Develops skills in fundraising, marketing, promotion through course projects
- Emphasizes professionalism and resourcefulness, applicable to all careers
- Fosters entrepreneurship and builds careers in community labs

- Strengthens the town-gown relationship through Chapel Hill lab
